### REBUILD CHURCH, REBUILD HOPE

#### A Collection for New Orleans and Biloxi

In June, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) created the special collection "Rebuild Church, Rebuild Hope" in response to the immense need for additional financial resources to aid the continuing recovery efforts in the Archdiocese of New Orleans and the Diocese of Biloxi. These two dioceses, so devastated by the ravages of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita, are still in a state of unimaginable need.

The purpose is to aid in the recovery efforts of the Archdiocese of New Orleans and the Diocese of Biloxi—60% of the collection will go to New Orleans and the remaining 40% to Biloxi.

This collection will provide the immense help needed to rebuild the churches, schools, and services that allow the Church to bring hope and minister to God's people. Last year's collection focused on immediate humanitarian relief and only scratched the surface of the needs involved. This collection focuses on rebuilding churches, schools, and other essential parts of the parishes' infrastructure that are needed to rebuild people's hope. The collection will take place on August 26-27. Please give generously.
