

SOURCE AND EXPLANATION OF INTERIOR DESIGN OF CHURCH

- **“Angel Doors” crafted by Daprato-Rigali for Queen of Peace, and funded by an anonymous donor. (Daprato-Rigali designed and supervised the remodeling of the Church.)**
- **Choir Loft: Stained glass rose window in the ancient Eastern spiritual symbol of the mandala. Saint Cecilia, Patron Saint of Musicians, is symbolized in the center of the window.**
- **Organ by Rodgers Organ, Holy Family**
- **Right side of church as you enter:**
 - **Back wall:**
 - **Ambry for Holy Oils, crafted by Daprato-Rigali for Queen of Peace.**
 - **Votive Light at Holy Oils Ambry donated by Saint Andrew’s Episcopal Church, Grayslake.**
 - **Pieta (Sorrowful Mother with Jesus), Mother of God.**
 - **Statues of Saint Jude and the Infant of Prague, Holy Rosary.**
 - **Votive Light Stands, Holy Family and Holy Rosary.**
 - **Side Wall:**
 - **Statue of Saint Joseph, Holy Rosary.**
 - **Stained glass windows depicting the Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary.**
 - **Side Crucifix, Holy Family**
 - **Founder’s Chapel Stained Glass Window crafted by Daprato-Rigali for Queen of Peace and funded by an anonymous donor.**
 - **Founder’s Chapel Votive Light, Holy Rosary.**
 - **Paschal Candle Stand, Anonymous Donor.**
 - **Side Altar**
 - **Statue of Sacred Heart of Jesus, Holy Rosary**
 - **Symbols on Ceiling (from back of church)**
 - **Scales with flower and rod representing the justice and mercy of God.**
 - **Dove representing the Holy Spirit.**
 - **Peter’s Crown representing the Apostolic succession of our Popes as Bishops of Rome.**
 - **Doves at font with cross and grapes representing the fountain of salvation.**
 - **Chalice, host and keys representing the power of the Church to bind and to loose.**

- **Left Side of Church as you enter:**
 - **Statue of Mary, Queen of Peace, Saint Therese Medical center.**
 - **Stained glass windows depicting the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary.**
 - **Icon of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Holy Rosary.**
- **Symbols on ceiling (from back of church)**
 - **Eye of God in triangle representing the Trinity and our All-seeing, All-knowing God.**
 - **INRI with crown of thorns and nails representing Jesus' crucifixion.**
 - **Pelican with chicks in nest representing Christ feeding his Church.**
 - **Lamb on book with cross on banner representing the lamb that was slain, with a banner representing His resurrection.**
- **Side altar:**
 - **Statue of Mary with Child Jesus, Holy Rosary.**
- **Sanctuary:**
 - **Center altar fabricated from original back altar as part of remodeling.**
 - **Last Supper inset in center altar donated by Rygiel family.**
 - **Bronze Crucifix above back altar crafted and donated by Daprato-Rigali. (Replaced by statue of the Risen Christ during the Easter Season.)**
 - **Stained glass windows depicting the Sorrowful Mysteries.**
 - **Symbols for the Four Evangelists, the Holy Eucharist, and the Holy Spirit on the dome of the sanctuary.**
 - **Sanctuary lamp a gift from Deacon Mike Boucha in memory of his wife, Mary Ann.**
 - **Candlesticks and candelabra from all three parishes.**
 - **Chalices and Ciboria, Holy Family, Holy Rosary, Mother of God.**
- **Stations of the Cross, Mother of God.**
- **Mission Statement crafted by Daprato-Rigali.**
- **Holy Week Cross crafted by Walter Macrowski.**
- **Processional Crosses (for Parish opening):**
 - **Icon-Style, Christ the High Priest.**
 - **Resurrection Cross (without the Body of Jesus).**
